30 June: Pray for Egypt!

Last Sunday 4 Shiites were lynched by a mob of Salafists, in Giza just outside the city of Cairo. Also, the Egyptian army has announced that they will intervene if President Morsi's government is not able to handle the situation in the country, should the demonstrations on 30 June get out of control



The demonstrations announced for Sunday 30 June are expected to be huge and may turn into a bloody event. The people of Egypt want President Morsi and his government to leave and have chosen the date of the president's installation in 2012 to vent their feelings.

The economic situation in Egypt is horrendous, and the people in the street cannot see any successful steps taken by the present government to improve the situation in the country. Besides, the police is either invisible or turns a blind eye to events like the one of last Sunday.

We urgently request your prayers for the country of Egypt these days, and for the more than 80 million people who live there. And we ask your special prayers for the churches and the Christians in that country, that they may witness to the love and grace of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Finding Christ in the Coffeeshop

The majority of Arab youth and adolescents are not used to talking about basic biblical principles in their own 'jargon'. Most of the time issues like 'sin and grace, forgiveness and reconciliation, justification and sanctification' are not translated into a language that has to do with the way they think and talk. But the young people of today are the (church) leaders of the future. We want to support the local churches in the Arab world to equip their young people better, by producing 13 TV programs filmed in the coffeeshop and in the jargon they use when they meet in the coffeeshop.



The presenter will be the representative for Alpha in one of the countries of the Middle East. By choosing this approach we also expect to reach thousands of young people who are interested in Christianity but have only a limited knowledge.

Please pray for this project, and if you can, give! Each episode of about 30 minutes costs 65 pound or 100 dollar per produced minute. As these programs will be broadcast several times by several broadcasters, the cost per watched minute will only be 5 pound or 8 dollar. Some of our earliest programs are still being shown, some 15 years after they were first broadcast.
