Atheism and the Arab World...

That does not look like a very obvious combination! However, a growing number of young people has started to question traditions and doctrines and, what is more, has begun to openly discuss their doubts.

Arab Vision is responding to this growing trend with two new series of programmes. The first one will have the spotlight on families who have to deal with young people who have doubts, relatives who openly call themselves atheists. Nobody is used to have an open conversation about believing or not believing, and this is the purpose of the programmes: to open up the conversation, to give room for questions and doubts. No ready-made answers, but a search for the essence of faith together.

In the second series the focus will be on answering questions of Christians who are in doubt and Muslims who are searching. We will produce a series of 3 minute programmes in which Biblical truths will be discussed in an inviting and challenging way. Read more on [these projects](#) on our site.
