This is not just any number. 999,341 is the number of likes, comments and shares on our Light of the World Facebook channel. A channel aimed to share the gospel in the Arab world and focusing on young men and women, singles and starting families. A place for them to find a Christian community.

It resulted in 96,734 private messages received, 19,206 conversations, 1,433 times that Bibles or Christian materials were sent and 123 professions of faith.

And that is just one channel. Arab Vision is also present on Instagram, TikTok, Soundcloud and Sat TV. Just to mention a few other channels: Hope for Tomorrow: 23,313 messages received, The Secret: 79,280 messages received, Khatwa: 42,382 messages received, etcetera.

These numbers show the power of social media that provide opportunities for reaching people with the gospel in places where that may otherwise be difficult. And to do that with a relatively small team and limited resources. We share more about that in this annual report.

Behind those numbers are individual people, like Ramzi from Algeria. He is 25 years old. Jesus Christ touched his heart when he was young, and he loves Jesus and the church. He bought a Bible, but a leader of the mosque ripped the holy Bible into pieces. The counsellor shared with him how to accept Jesus. He said that Jesus Christ is in my heart.

Our counsellor sent him the follow-up lessons and some spiritual growth lessons about prayer and reading the Bible and how to be sure of salvation. Also, what to do when you fall into sin. He was very responsive to all these lessons and follow-ups.

This is just one example of many people that Arab Vision aims to reach and support to become disciples of Jesus Christ. We feel privileged to be instruments in God's hand. It is not always easy, but people like Ramzi make it worthwhile.



We are also grateful for other people, churches and organizations supporting our work with finances and prayers. Together we are part of God's mission to reach all people, also those living in the Arab world today.

Vision and Mission

Vision Statement

We envision an Arab World with, in each people group, an increasing number of vibrant churches that play a strategic public role in shaping their societies in accordance with the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ.



With the term ‘Arab World’ we mean the countries of the Arabian Peninsula, the Middle East and North Africa, where Arabic is the first official language of the state. We recognise that the Arab World consists of many different people groups, and we hold that these are all entitled to hearing the Gospel in their own languages.

Mission Statement

Arab Vision is a community of Christians committed to changing individuals and societies through the Gospel of Jesus Christ, using modern media.

Emphasis is on producing and distributing effective Christian video programs, and on providing follow-up, discipleship and counselling.

We use social media platforms and satellite TV for sharing our content with various target audiences, in the languages of the peoples of the Arab World.

Arab Vision: A Community of Christians

Our Mission Statements state that Arab Vision is a community of Christians. Almost 90% of our staff and volunteers are Arab Christians, based in the Middle East.

In 2024 we had 23 Arab and 3 non-Arab staff members (a mix of full-time and part-time), all of them deeply dedicated to Christ, and to their work in the ministry of Arab Vision. Some worked in the production of our videos for social media and TV, most work as social media and follow-up staff, and some in administration, management and fundraising.

Creating a good atmosphere that boosts employee morale provides many benefits, including improved productivity, increased creativity, stress reduction and strong company loyalty and all employees sharing their ideas for planning / goals and the follow-up.

Arab Vision seeks to help staff members to develop themselves, in their professional field and personally. Many of the individual staff members received training in specific fields during 2024, including financial management, implementing artificial intelligence, communication and writing skills, designing online courses, etc. Staff meetings were held weekly and several times in 2024 all staff enjoyed some teambuilding days away from the workplace.

Some families among our staff struggle with the care for their children with special needs. In their country it is hard to find the right treatment, and to be able to pay for that, once it is found. In 2023 we set up a special fund for this, to support our staff and their families, reflecting being a community.





Productions

It is Arab Vision's goal to produce quality programs that are thought-provoking and tailor made for different audiences.

In 2024 we produced 282 short clips and programs of about 4 minutes, 106 programs of about 15-20 minutes, and 70 video songs.

In addition we produced the voice-over for 40 sand art Bible stories in Yemeni, Moroccan, and Libyan Arabic.

Easter 2024: A new dawn

We produced 66 devotional episodes and 70 songs that celebrate the meaning of Easter and its transformative power in our lives. The series explores the depth of Holy Week and Easter through various themes and perspectives.

With Bishop Thomas we delve into the significance of Coptic rituals during Holy Week and Easter, uncovering their spiritual depth and symbolism.



With various Protestant pastors and leaders we explore how with Easter sadness turns into joy, fear into peace, despair into determination, doubt into faith and weakness into strength. We consider the characters of Mary the mother of Jesus, Mary Magdalene, Salome, Joseph of Arimathea, Nicodemus and Simon of Cyrene. We explore the themes of Christ's victory of death and sin, the need for a sacrifice, the power of Christ's blood, the Passover lamb and its fulfilment in Christ. We examine key moments in Christ's journey: the washing of feet, Peter's denial and Christ's sermon in the synagogue of Nazareth.

Christmas 2024 - Hospital Bethlehem

Hospital Bethlehem is an allegorical drama series reimagining the Holy Family's flight to Egypt within the symbolic setting of a modern hospital. Through 15 short episodes, the series blends suspense, spiritual symbolism, and modern struggles to explore themes of divine providence, persecution, and faith. The narrative follows Joseph, Mary, and the newborn "Emmanuel" as they evade a tyrannical hospital director (representing Herod) while navigating challenges that mirror both biblical and contemporary life.

Sandy Tales are Bible stories through sand art. In 2024 translation and audio recording has taken place of 22 stories in Libyan Arabic, 22 in Moroccan Arabic and 8 in Yemeni Arabic. This project is done in cooperation with Jesus Net.

Who do you say I am, season 3



In 2021 we produced the first series of programs (86 short clips) with this title, based on Jesus' question to his disciples in Matthew 16.15 and on many questions asked of or by Jesus in the New Testament. They are presented by renowned Bible teacher Youssef Nathan and aim to find answers to the many complicated questions Muslims and Christians struggle with today. In 2022 we completed the filming of 67 clips, season 2 based on the questions Jesus asks in his parables. In 2023 and 2024 we produced season 3, of 70 episodes of 10 minutes and developed training courses on the subjects. (See e-courses)

Project Mark - the Gospel for Libya

In 6 short programs of 5 minutes the evangelist Mark himself tells us how he brought the Gospel to Libya and how it spread across North Africa. The series start with the evangelist Mark, and features Tertullian, Cyprian, Perpetua and Simon of Cyrene. The programs have been produced in a docudrama format and will be followed by a series of testimonies and devotionals by Libyan Christians. We have finished the production in Egyptian Arabic and are still in the process of finishing the testimonies, hymns and devotionals in Libyan Arabic.



Both Christians and Muslims often have no idea that the very country, in which they live, once had such a thriving Christian community. The country is still full of - largely undiscovered - remains of this Early Church.

Beloved - be a man

In 2024 we have produced 15 clips of this program.

The goals of this program are to raise awareness and support Arab men in the roles they take or should take in society, the family, and the church. The program aims to provide tools and resources for Arab men to better equip themselves for these roles in changing societies. Additionally, the program seeks to challenge harmful cultural stereotypes and expectations that may negatively impact Arab men's self-perception and limit their potential.

Some of the key issues that the program addresses include: gender roles, family dynamics, personal development, spirituality, and cultural traditions. By exploring these issues and providing a platform for Arab men to share their experiences and perspectives, the program hopes to foster a more nuanced and inclusive understanding of masculinity and support the growth and development of Arab men in their various roles.

Short video clips on various subjects by different speakers - season 3

We have produced 185 short video clips with a variety of speakers on diverse and impactful topics, designed to engage and educate audiences.

Key topics covered:

- * **Adolescence:** 72 episodes addressing key challenges teenagers face, fostering better parent-teen communication, debunking misconceptions about teenage behaviour, and promoting understanding as the foundation for success.
- * **Be a man:** 43 episodes covering topics such as respecting boundaries, leadership in the household, overcoming fear of commitment, building healthy relationships, emotional intelligence, and living by principles.
- * **Faith fundamentals:** 13 episodes exploring why God created us, the concept of sin, repentance, and the role of the Holy Spirit in our lives.
- * **Money management:** 12 episodes providing practical guidance on financial responsibility and stewardship.
- * **Life stories:** 19 episodes illustrating Christian principles through real-life experiences and their practical application.

1. Perception - Idrak

Idrak is a thought-provoking podcast featuring engaging discussions and a song in each episode. The program explores deep philosophical and theological questions, encouraging critical thinking and meaningful dialogue. Each episode is 20 minutes long, divided into short clips to suit social media platforms. Every episode includes a hymn.

This podcast aims to engage a wide audience by addressing relevant and thought-provoking topics in an accessible format, making theological discussions more approachable for modern listeners.

2. Roadsigns

This program offers a valuable resource for spiritual education and discipleship. Its short format makes it accessible for daily reflection, while its depth ensures relevance for both new and mature believers. 27 episodes of 5 minutes each. Every episode unpacks a specific theme through spiritual analysis, real-life applications and actionable advice.

Some themes covered:

- Walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh (Galatians 5:16)
- Understanding the conflict between flesh and spirit.
- Identifying battles against sin, temptation, and worldly influences.
- Sowing and reaping
- Do not cast away your confidence (Hebrews 10:35)
- Encouragement to persevere in faith during trials.
- Ethical living, resisting temptation, and maintaining spiritual integrity.

3. Perspectives - dialogues on life and faith

Perspectives is a conversational program of 13 episodes. Each episode is about 5-7 minutes. Hosted by two speakers, the series addresses diverse and timely topics sourced from social media platforms. It offers thoughtful, faith-based discussions aimed at fostering reflection, empathy, and spiritual growth.

Some themes covered:

- Exploring human struggles and divine wisdom in hardship.
- Navigating loneliness and finding connection through faith.
- Challenging societal biases and promoting compassion.
- Understanding grief and seeking hope in spiritual truths.
- Trusting in God's justice and restoration in times of loss.

4. Parenting

Parenting is a series of 12 short episodes (2 - 3 minutes) to equip parents with practical strategies for nurturing children in today's complex world.

Some themes covered:

- Quality time with children
- Common parenting mistakes
- Identifying and correcting habits that hinder healthy development.
- Love and firmness
- Effective communication of instructions
- Moving from authoritarian commands to collaborative guidance.
- Creating a safe space for children to express themselves.

5. Perspectives and controversies on the Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit, exploring identity, role and fruit is a 26 episode theological series. Each episode lasts 4 minutes. The program delves into foundational and nuanced aspects of the Holy Spirit's nature, work, and relationship with believers. It combines scriptural exegesis, doctrinal clarity, and practical application to deepen understanding of this central yet often misunderstood figure of the Christian faith.

Some themes covered:

- Exploring the Holy Spirit's identity as part of the Trinity.
- The Divinity of the Holy Spirit
- His indwelling presence, empowerment, and intercession.
- The fruit of the Holy Spirit
- Misconceptions about the Holy Spirit, His role in prayer, and transforming believers' lives.

6. Prisons in the Bible - Lessons from captivity

Lessons from captivity is a series of 6 episodes of each 4 minutes. The program examines the lives of biblical figures who endured imprisonment or confinement, drawing spiritual insights into faith, resilience, and divine purpose. Through scriptural narratives, the series highlights how God's sovereignty transforms suffering into redemption.

Joseph: Betrayal and unjust imprisonment - Jeremiah: The prophet in the dungeon - John the Baptist: Imprisoned for boldness - Peter: miraculous deliverance - Paul and Silas: Worship in chains - John the Beloved: Exile on Patmos

7. Stories of spiritual wisdom

Ten episodes of each 3 minutes offer listeners practical insights for deepening their faith and navigating life's challenges.

Topics include: true value, the trap of pride, sowing and reaping, the spiritual law of consequences, complaint and grumbling.

The Heritage Project

The Heritage Project is a series of 8 x 30 minute programs depicting Christians who lived in North Africa during the first five centuries AD. The series is a great encouragement for the Christians in that region and an eye-opener to many who do not know the message of the Gospel. In previous years the series of 8 episodes was finalized in Egyptian Arabic (watch Anthony), 8 episodes were produced in Moroccan Darija ([watch the life of Victor](#)), and 8 in Tunisian Arabic ([watch the life of Tertullian](#)) and in Moroccan Tachelhit.

Episodes in Kabyle and Moroccan Chaoui are work in progress. In 2024 we filmed the Algerian version with a native Algerian narrator.

Towards a better future

Towards a better future consists of two parts. Part one is the production of 6 engaging videos of each approximately 5 minutes that vividly illustrate the impact of climate change on Egypt's environment. Part two are interactive workshops, where children not only learn about the effects of climate change but also participate in practical experiments to witness firsthand the environmental consequences of our actions.

The video series is developed in partnership with local organizations, ensuring the content is both authentic and grounded in the local context.

Some of the topics include:

- The negative impacts of burning waste.
- Sustainable methods of resource utilization.
- Energy conservation and water management.
- Proper waste sorting at the source.
- The critical role of the Nile River and the need to protect it from pollution and waste.
- Preserving the natural ecosystem and migratory birds
- Optimizing electricity and water usage.
- Emphasizing the role of doormen in conserving water

She tells us that God's grace can turn a thief into a servant of the Lord, even when we have doubts or are weak. That same grace works faith in us. We may learn to follow the Lord Jesus. I would like to follow the Lord Jesus and help the people around me.

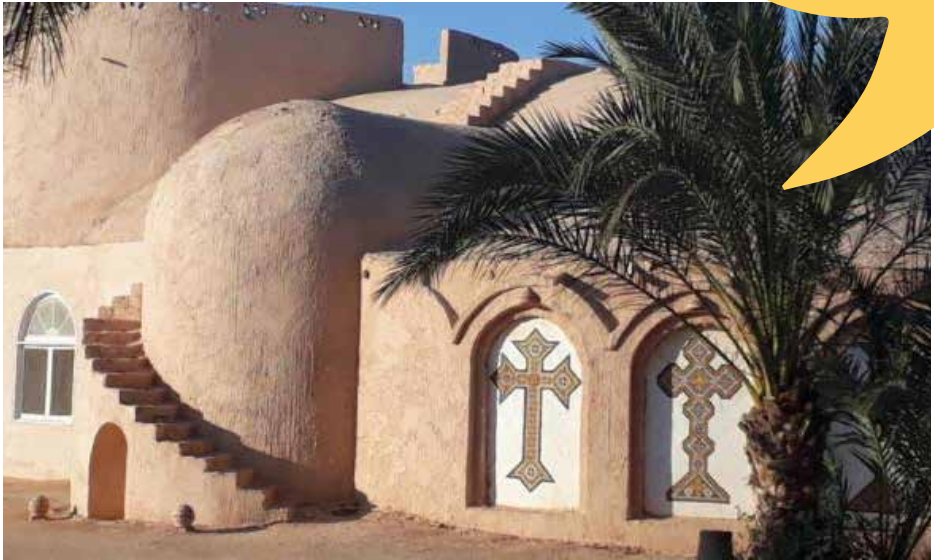


I want to listen to God's plan with my life

Khadidja, a young Algerian Muslim woman is very concerned about what she thinks she needs in her life: a job, a life partner, a nice flat, a car and much more. But she is afraid of not achieving all those goals. We engage her in a conversation about the role of God in her life, that the future does not depend on what someone thinks they need for themselves, that God's plan gives real value to our life on earth. We challenge Khadidja to engage God. After a while, we reconnect and she writes: 'I want to listen to God's plan with my life and align my future with what He wants!'

Yes, I love Jesus and his words

Hassan is a middle-aged man from Egypt. He is a Muslim and has good friends who are Christians. He contacts us via Facebook in response to a dream he had. The Coptic Pope had given him a rose in his dream. We talk to him about the words of the Lord Jesus: 'I am the way, the truth and the life'. Hasan enjoys talking to us and finally says, "Yes, I love Jesus Christ and His people. I really want to know more about his good life. These words of his give me great satisfaction.'

Bishoy from Egypt experiences a renewal of his spiritual life after Philip, our e-coach, has disciple him for a while. He writes: 'Thank you, you helped me a lot through our conversations! I have hope again. I have started reading the Bible. I have ignored all pornography and deleted a lot from Facebook. I am putting my trust in God again, asking for His help, with a renewed desire to do His will.'

I felt hope and confidence

Souhir in Tunisia is a Muslima. She would like to know more about the Christian faith because she believes that Christians are honest people. We send her the text of the Sermon on the Mount. She likes it very much. She also says: “When I read Christian teaching, I felt hope and trust in God. It’s very true. Every word gave me hope. I am a Muslima, but I agree with this education.’ We also send her the Jesus movie. She can’t believe that Jesus was really crucified.

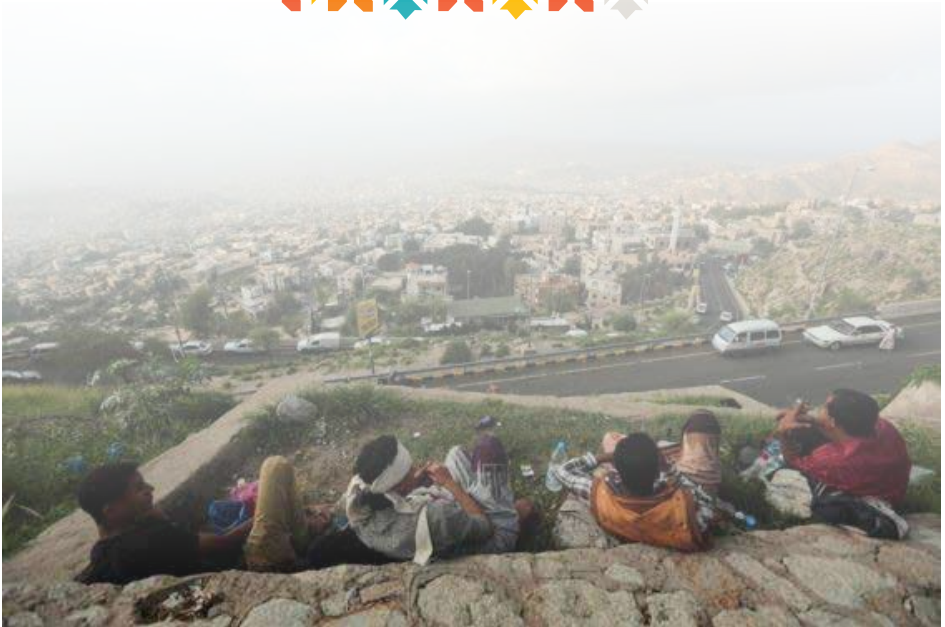


I want to be baptized

Anwar from North Africa responds to a program about forgiveness. Our counsellor asks him whether he knows Jesus. To his surprise Anwar tells him that ten years ago he decided to become a follower of Christ, but until now he has not been baptized. He really wants to take that step, but feels too shy. ‘Please pray for me, that I will find the courage to follow my desire to be baptised’, Anwar asked.

I have found my security in Jesus

Fathi is 30 years old, married and father of four children. On his timeline on Facebook, he occasionally sees Khatwa's posts. He has already become interested in the Christian faith through other pages. He feels a personal deep calling to seek God and to fill the spiritual emptiness in him. What touches him about the posts on Khatwa is the focus on the explanation in the Yemeni context. What do his people need in the face of war? Fathi comes to our discipleship course through online conversations with the Follow-up. There he continues to grow in his faith. Fathi does not keep the hope and love of Jesus to himself, but he shares it with the young people in his village. The challenges are not over yet, but Fathi has found his security in Jesus.

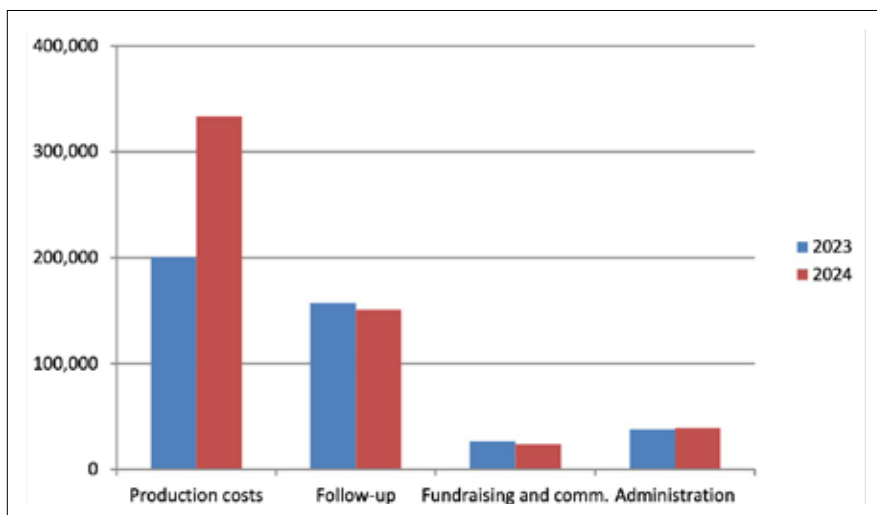

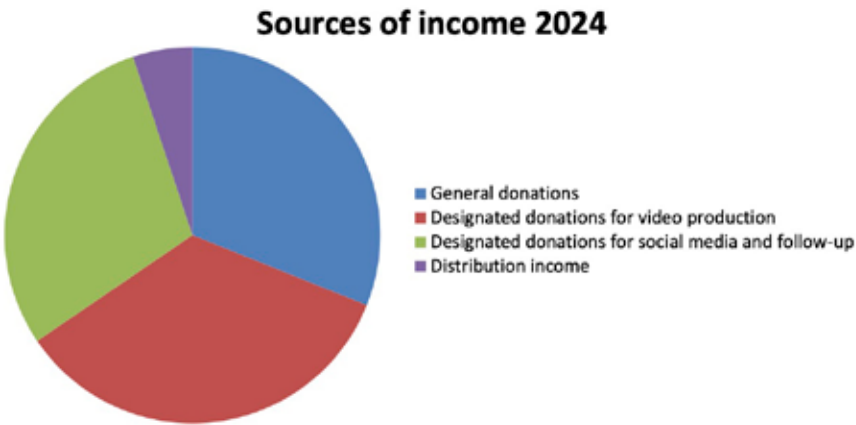
